Do you grow **Dahlia's or Roses?** We have 17 classes that you can enter!

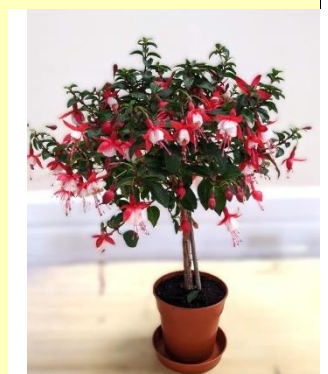
